Do I Qualify?

- Is your income between 30-80% Area Median Income?
- Do you have a positive history of meeting your financial obligations?
- Are you able to maintain your home in a decent and safe condition?
- Do not have criminal history that would adversely affect the health, safety, or well-being of other residents or staff or cause damage to the property.
- Have not committed fraud in connection with any Federal housing assistance program.
- Do not have a history of abusing alcohol in a way that may interfere with the health, safety, or right to peaceful enjoyment by others.

If you answered YES to these questions, you *may* qualify for Public Housing. Submit your completed application to be placed on the waiting list. Please understand that you will be placed on a Waiting List. This is not immediate housing. Also, please submit an application only if you are truly interested in Public Housing.
